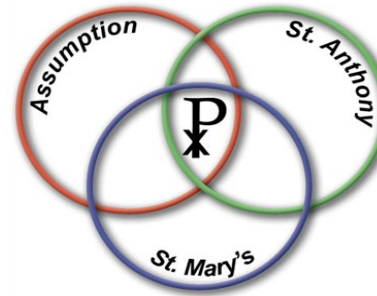

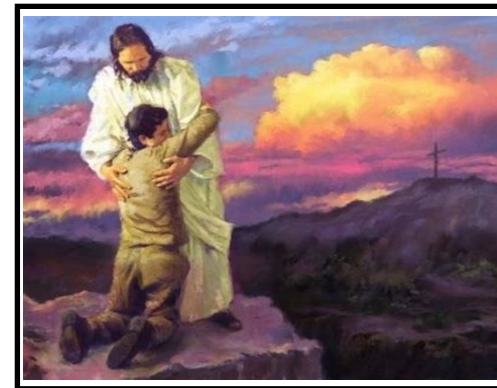

Father's Corner:

Bible: Continued Part #5:
 The Bible needs to be translated for most people to read and understand it, because, as I wrote before, it was originally written in Hebrew and Greek which very few people can read today. The Bible needs to be continually revised into new versions or retranslated

because English, indeed all spoken languages, is a living language. A living language is one that is being used and is always adapting to new situations and meanings. For example, 40 years ago "viral" was related to or caused by a virus, now it means becoming very popular by circulating quickly from person to person through the internet. While a "Tweet" used to mean a chirping note not it means a very short message posted on the Twitter site. As our modern words change, we need new translations that keep the original meaning intact and easy to read and understand. For example, when the King James version of the Bible that the Protestants used for so long was a modern English translation when it was first written in the 1611. At that time, people spoke with thee and thou. Now English does not use these words so more modern translations use you and yours instead.

For Liturgies, each national bishops' conference decides which translation will be used during liturgy. Therefore. If you travel to a different country the reading may sound a little different because they may be using a different translation. In the U.S., the readings at mass come from the New American Bible (Revised Ed.). Scholars recognizes that many Biblical passages come from the religious life of the Israelites and Christians people. Parts the Pentateuch was oral traditions for hundreds of years before being written and those traditions originated and were recited in liturgical events in Israel. The Psalms were religious poems and song that were used in worship of God. The same goes for parts of the New Testament like Mt 28:9 NS Mk 14:22-25. Liturgy is the place of the encounter between God and human. The Church receives and absorbs the divine Word and responds to the Word by prayer and worship. The self-revelation of God is now contained in the Bible, that we respond to in prayer so we can receive the fullness of God in His Son in the Eucharist and carry Him and His message of Love out into the world. The liturgy is also filled with Biblical texts. The new translation of the Mass and other liturgies makes this much clearer. Continued next week.
