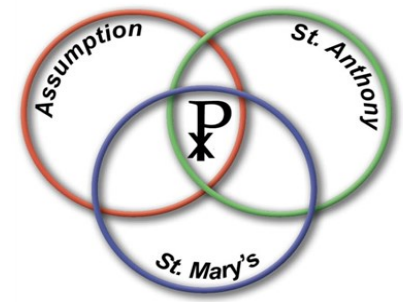

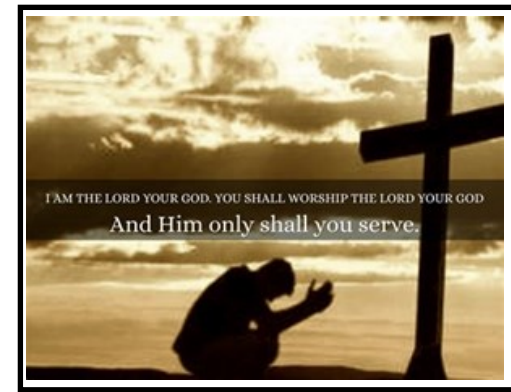

Father's Corner:
 Continuing with the Bible #6
 Private reading of the Bible is a natural extension of the public proclamation or the Word of God in Liturgies. Private reading of the Bible was always encouraged, but in the Middle Ages people quit reading the Scriptures because of not being able to read the language especially most people could not read nor understand the Latin that the Scriptures were written in. For Catholics, Pope Leo XIII in 1893 wrote an encyclical encouraging and providing guidance for Biblical studies and he also granted indulgences for reading the Gospels. Every Pope since then has encouraged the reading and study of the Scriptures.

For reading of the Bible, I would encourage several things: 1. Get a good Bible that has a print size you can easily read and the has foot notes and verse cross index notes. 2. Pick a book from the Bible and read through it. Do NOT try to read the Bible beginning to end when you first start to read the Bible, as you will not get through Leviticus and Numbers without giving up. 3. Remember that the Bible contains many different types of literature in it: Historical drama, law books, government history, wisdom writings, songs, poems, love poems, letters, apocalyptic writings, historical writings, and prophetic writings. Each type must be read differently, just as you would read a fiction book different from a book of instructions and different from a legal writing. 4. You have to consider why you are reading? Are you reading to study the Word of God and learn – in which case you need really good footnotes and maybe a commentary or two. Or reading for inspiration – so you read only very short section at a time. Are you reading for prayer and contemplation – for which you need time to stop and pray and listen to God.
