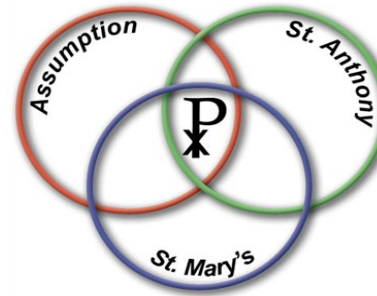

Father's Corner: At Adoration this morning, Wednesday, March 23rd, with the Jr High Students in our PFFP program. One of the children sneezed two different times and someone else said, "God bless you". I said, "thank you" to the person who had spoken. I received a few looks that seemed to say, "what are you talking about". Therefore, I

thought that I would take this as an opportunity to write and explain it to everyone since it was many years ago that I explained this Catholic Custom.

Back around 590AD, there was a plague sweeping what is now Europe, that caused uncontrollable sneezing or yawning until you died. I read that this is what killed Pope Pelagius II (579-590). When Pope Gregory the Great (590-604) became the Pope in 590AD, he issued a papal order that said when someone sneezes you are to say, "God Bless you" in case these are the last words that person hears, and it would be a prayer asking God to bless them.

Pope Gregory at the same time said that if someone yawns, then you make the Sign of the Cross over their mouth, in case they drop dead. Then the last thing that happens to them while they are alive is that someone blesses them. Over the centuries, I believe that this has become "cover your mouth when you yawn".

Another common Catholic practice that is part of our culture is to say or do "Knock on Wood" to express thanks or a hope that something bad did not or will not happen to us. This custom comes from our "Veneration of the Cross" on Good Friday. The words that I was taught to say while knocking on wood was, "there but for the grace of God go I". It is a pray of thanksgiving that this bad thing did not happen to me, or it is a pray of petition that this bad thing will Not happen t me.
