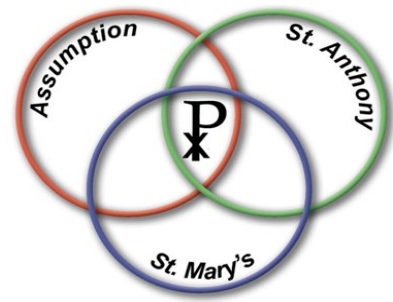

Father's Corner:

Palm Sunday. Next weekend is Palm Sunday. It is the beginning of Holy Week. In this celebration we receive Palm Branches and celebrate Jesus' last triumphant entrance into Jerusalem, which was understood to be God's city. The people celebrated Him as the Messiah/Savior. Then only a few days later they would be yelling "Crucify Him, Crucify Him". This entry into the Holy City is important for us to for a couple of reasons.

First reason is that it is part of the life of Jesus and the beginning of His Passion, Death and Resurrection. This is understood as all being one event. It is the beginning of Jesus Triumph over Sin, Evil and Death. The Palm branches were the normal way of celebrating a great Victory. When the military or local sports team came back after a victory, they were greeted with a parade of Palm branches. By greeting Jesus in this way we are showing that He has won the Victory.

Second is that we are celebrating Jesus' entry into our hearts and lives. Just like there were a few days between His entry into Jerusalem and His Death and Resurrection, so there are a few days - ok years and decades hopefully, between when Jesus enters into our lives at the moment of our Baptism and when we unite with Him by our death and then can be united with Him in the Resurrection.

In celebrating Palm Sunday, we celebrate our being raised to eternal life with God in Heaven. As Jesus lived the History of Israel in His lifetime. But unlike the Israelites, Jesus never sinned. You and I live the Life of Jesus in our lifetimes. The question then becomes, do we live it without sin as Jesus did?
