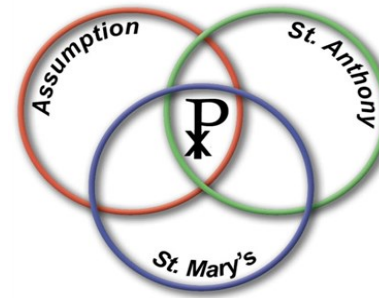

**Father's Corner:**

Feast of the Most Holy Trinity. Last Sunday, we celebrated Pentecost and the full revelation of God as a Trinity of Persons with the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. Now today, we especially try to understand the Holy Trinity. This is the central mystery of the Christian Faith. Mystery in theology means something we cannot fully understand. We cannot understand this Mystery because we are not God. Only God can fully understand God. So we try to understand and grasp what we can of the true nature of one God and three Persons in the One God.

The Feast is celebrating the dogma of the three Persons in one God. God has one nature - Divine - however, there are three distinct Persons in that one Divine nature: the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. The three Divine Persons are coequal, coeternal, and consubstantial. While the term "Trinity" is not in Scriptures, the reality of the Triune God is present in Christ's references to the Father and to the Spirit. The inner life of the Triune God is a life of pure mutual interrelations in knowledge and in love.

All life begins in the Trinity, comes from the Trinity, and is destined to end in the Trinity. Every liturgical action begins "In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit". Our Baptism is in the name of the Trinity; therefore, we can celebrate the Covenant and enter into the very life of the Three Divine Persons as the Body of Christ into the life of the Son flowing to the Father by the Holy Spirit., This Feast has been celebrated since the 8<sup>th</sup> Century and was moved to the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday after Pentecost in the 12<sup>th</sup> Century
