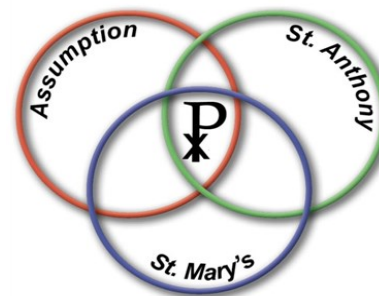

#### Father's Corner:

Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (AKA Corpus Christi).

This Feast is to honor the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharistic; and it recalls and celebrates the institution of the Eucharistic on Holy Thursday; when sorrow over the Passion of Christ hinders the celebration of this great Sacrament.

This Feast was first celebrated in 1264 and was promoted by visions that Juliana of Liege, an Augustinian nun had, that told her that God wanted a feast to honor the Blessed Sacrament. Shortly thereafter the Feast spread to the whole Church. The celebration can include Eucharistic Processions. Remember, that during the Dark ages, like the 1200's, most people felt too unworthy to receive the Eucharist, so the need to see the Host and to adore the Eucharistic placed on the Altar grew in importance.

During this Feast, we give special thanks and praise to God for this gift of His Body and Blood that Christ gave to us at the Last Supper. The Eucharistic is: 1) the living Memorial of Jesus' Passion, Death, and Resurrection: and brings us its sacrificial and saving power until the end of time. 2) It is the Sacrament by which we encounter the living risen Christ and receive strength so we can all walk in one communion of Love. 3) It is the Saving Banquet in which we are fed at God's table and grow in the holiness of the Risen Christ.
