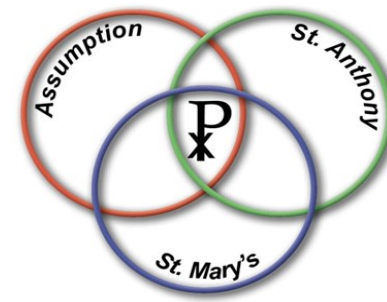

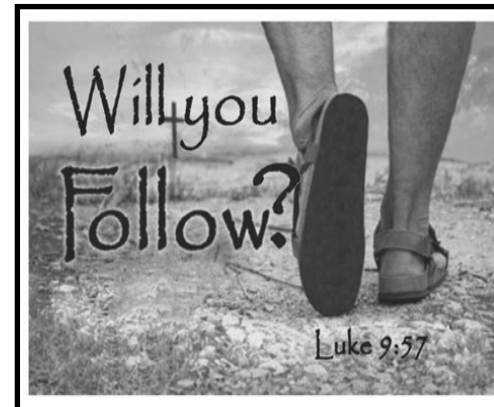

**Father's Corner:**

We now reenter the part of the Church's Liturgical Year called "Ordinary Time". Ordinary time is the longest season of the year and is divided into two parts. The first part is between Epiphany and Lent and the second part goes between Pentecost and Advent. In Ordinary Time, the color used is green representing life on the path Jesus showed us and calls us to live. Altogether, Ordinary Times last 33 or 34 weeks. The reason the number of weeks can change by one is because how *Christmas* and the *Feast of the Baptism of the Lord* can change days of the week. It is called ordinary to distinguish it from the other seasons. Ordinary Time is the Sunday after celebration of the Paschal Mystery, and of our living the Paschal Mystery.

Ordinary Time begins the day after the Baptism of the Lord, which is on Sunday or Monday. Therefore, the first Sunday after the Baptism of the Lord, is called the Second Sunday of Ordinary Time. During this time, we have a semi continuous reading of one of the three Synoptic Gospels - this year it being the Gospel of Luke. The Gospel sets the tone for the Sunday celebration. Each Sunday we celebrate God's great deeds. We pray to the Father through the Son in unity with the Holy Spirit. Yet in each celebration, we enter into this action through ever-fresh facets of our faith as proclaimed in the Liturgy of the Word. In Ordinary Time the Church ask that we focus on what Jesus is trying to teach us, by His words and His miracles, about living the New Covenant
