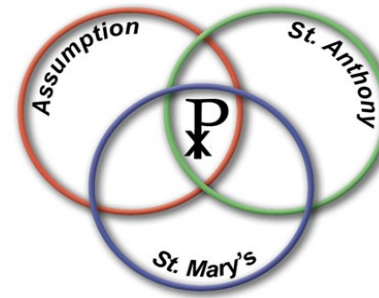

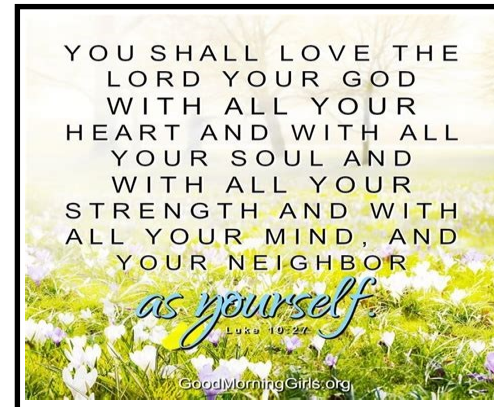

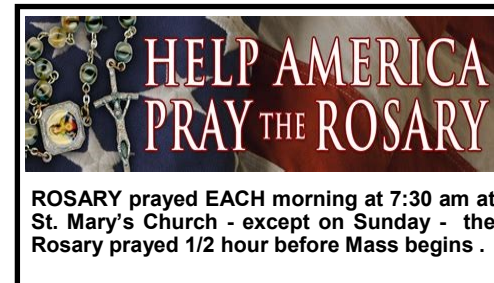

Father's Corner: Now that we have two Permanent Deacons serving in our Tri-Parishes we will occasionally have both serving a the same Mass. This is normal. Especially when a Bishop is presiding at Mass it is actually preferred to have two deacons. So how do we divide the Mass?

Instructions for celebrating Mass are in the GIRM (General Instructions for the Roman Missal) gives all the instructions and guidelines for celebrating the Mass, and the Rubrics in the Roman Missal. In the GIRM, section 109, it says that if there are several ministers present who are able to exercise the same ministry, they can distribute the different parts among themselves. What that means is that the Deacons can decide who does what during a Mass.

What is generally done is that one Deacon, called the Deacon of the Word, will do the deacon parts of the Mass for the "Introductory Rites" and the "Liturgy of the Word." The second Deacon, called the Deacon of the Altar, will do all the deacon parts of the Mass for the "Liturgy of the Eucharist" and the "Closing Rites." Sometimes the Deacon of the Liturgy of the Word will assist the Deacon of the Altar in receiving the gifts and bringing the vessels to the Deacon of the Altar. This flexibility is different than having two or more priests concelebrating the same Mass. For Priests, there is the main Presider and any other Priest is called a Concelebrant. The parts a Concelebrant can do is strictly specified in the GIRM and the Rubrics.
