



Father's Corner:
The Mystery of the Eucharist in the
Life of the Church. Part 5.

Having received the Eucharist and given thanks, our next response is for each of us to be Transformed into Christ. When we worthily share in the Eucharist, we receive the grace to imitate the love that Christ shows us. This is both a personal and moral transformation that flows in and through all our relationships with our family, friends and neighbors and reaching out to reshape our society. We are called to bring the Love of Christ not only to our private lives, but to every dimension of our public lives: to our political, economic, and social lives.

Because of our Communion through the Eucharist with one another: we are called to work for the common good of all people. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church states, "Eucharist commits us to the poor" (CCC1397).

St. Teresa of Calcutta said, that "in beholding the face of Christ in the Eucharist, she learned to recognize his face in the poor and suffering". Pope Francis has warned us all that in our "throwaway culture" we must fight the tendency to see people as "disposable" if they are not seen as useful: like the poor, disabled, unborn and elderly. "As Christians we bear the responsibility to promote the life and dignity of the human person, and to love and protect the most vulnerable in our midst: the unborn, migrants and refugees, victims of racial injustice, the sick and the elderly."
