



Father's Corner:

The Mystery of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church: Part 6 While it is obvious that the Kingdom of God has not been fully established in our world, the Kingdom is present. The Kingdom of

God came in the person of Christ, and it grows in the hearts of those who belong to Him, us in the Church. The Eucharist, calls us, and enables us, to conversion. And in our communion with one another and all of creation, we are called to convert all creation. We are made new by the Love of God so that we can change the rules, the quality of relationships and transform social structures.

The Call to Conversion: Christ began His public ministry calling people to repentance and conversion, and to believe in the gospel (Mk 1:15; Mt 4:17). Therefore, at the beginning of each Mass to prepare ourselves to celebrate the Eucharist, we acknowledge our sins, confess that we have sinned and implore the Lord's mercy. The mercy we see and receive in His Sacrifice in the Eucharist.

Our sins, damage our communion with God and with each other. However, sins can differ in degrees of severity. Venial sins are not taken lightly, but they do not destroy our communion by destroying the principle of divine life within us. Pope Francis pointed out the medicinal character of the Eucharist, "is not a prize for the perfect but a powerful medicine and nourishment for the weak".

Some sins, however, do rupture our communion with God, the Church, and cause grave offense to human dignity. These are called "grave" or "mortal" sins. They are committed freely, knowingly and willingly choosing a grave matter opposed to charity, love of God and love of neighbor. A person should not receive Holy Communion with "mortal" sins on their soul.
