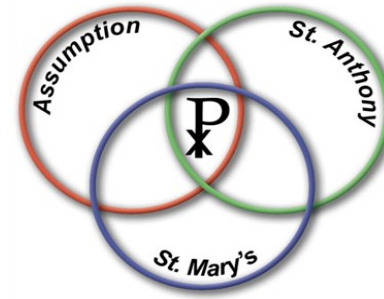

Father's Corner:

The Mystery of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church: Part 8

The importance and call of the Eucharist.

The lives of the saints and blessed show us the importance of the Eucharist on our journey. In union with Jesus through Holy Communion and in frequent prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, they were strengthened and grew in Christian life.

In recent years, we have seen Catholics who have left the Church or no longer practice the faith. We invite them to come home. "We miss you and we love you." Saint Teresa of Calcutta said: "Once you understand the Eucharist, you can never leave the Church. Not because the Church won't let you but because your heart won't let you."

Pope Benedict XVI said that we cannot keep the love of the sacrament to ourselves. By its own nature, the Eucharist demands to be shared by all. Each of us is called to help the world encounter Christ and to believe in Him. The Eucharist is not only the summit of the Church's life, but it is also our mission. Jesus was sent by the Father for the salvation of the world, and we who receive the Body and Blood of Christ, are sent out to proclaim this Salvation of and to the world. We are "missionary disciples". Called to proclaim the Love of God. Love that is displayed most preeminently in the Eucharist.

I would ask those who hoped for or who wanted to use the Eucharist as a tool to further the divisions that are growing so strong in our country and those who want to condemn others to look into their own hearts. Ask yourselves, what would Jesus do? What is our loving and merciful Father asking of us? If Jesus could forgive those who killed Him; if Jesus can forgive us who crucify Him with our sins; can we not forgive?
