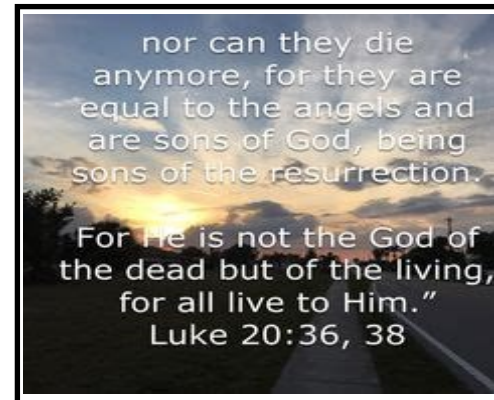
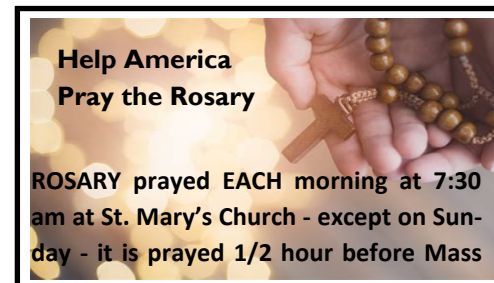

**Father's Corner:
Reflections from the Beach - #1**

As I was walking along the beach on the Oregon Coast I saw two seagulls standing on two different rocks. The birds were looking at the waves and picking at and

cleaning their wings and feathers. They didn't look like they had a care in the world. The water came in on wave after wave often completely surrounding the rocks, and the birds kept right on doing their thing. Then a bigger wave came in and changed things. The bird on the bigger rock kept right on cleaning his feathers while the other bird on the smaller rock all of a sudden found that he was standing in water. And he wasn't indifferent to the water anymore because the next wave that came in swept him off his feet and he had to swim. Meanwhile the bird on the bigger rock continued to ignore the water because he was high and dry.

Which rock are you standing on? "...you are the rock and on this rock I will found my church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." (Mt 16:18-19). The Catholic Church has stood for about 2000 years on this foundation stone that Jesus put in place. He taught the Apostles and He made firm this foundation. A foundation built with and by the power of God, by the Holy Spirit. We build upon this stone that Jesus made firm with the power of God.
