

# Father's Corner: "Our Lady of Lourdes"

Feast Day is February 11th.

This is a title for the Virgin Mary due to her appearances in Lourdes, France. There were nineteen apparitions of the "Lady" at Lourdes. The first was February 11, 1858. The Virgin Mary appeared to Bernadette Soubirous, age 14; Bernadette was there in the grotto collecting firewood with her sister, Toinette, and a

friend, Jeanne Abadie. Bernadette wrote about this first apparition, "I came back towards the grotto and started taking off my stockings to wade through the creek. I had hardly taken off the first stocking when I heard a sound like a gust of wind. Then I turned my head towards the meadow. I saw the trees quite still: I went on taking off my stockings. I heard the same sound again. As I raised my head to look towards the grotto, I saw a lady dressed in white, wearing a white dress, a blue girdle (sash) and a yellow rose on each foot, the same color as the chain of her rosary; the beads of the rosary were white ... from the niche, or rather the dark alcove behind it, came a dazzling light." The Lady invited Bernadette to pry the Rosary with her. She tried to keep this a secret, but Toinette told her mother. After parental cross-examination, she and her sister received punishment for their story.

Three days later, 14 February, Bernadette Soubirous returned to the grotto. She had brought holy water as test that the apparition was not of evil origin ... "The second time was the following Sunday ... then I started to throw holy water in her direction, and at the same time I said that if she came from God she was to stay, bit if not, she must go. She started to smile, and bowed - this was the second time." Bernadette Soubirous' birthday is January 7th.


