

Father's Corner: Jubilee part 1 or 2

2025 is a Jubilee Year for the Catholic Church. Jubilees, or Holy Years, are celebrated every 25 years and highlight a spiritual theme. This year's focus is "*Pilgrims of Hope.*"

Pope Francis encouraged the worldwide Church to "fan the flame of hope" in his letter announcing the Holy Year. The Pope said he wants "everyone to gain new strength and cer-

tainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart, and far-sighted vision."

Bishop Peter Christensen asks Idaho parishes to use existing liturgies and regional celebrations throughout the year to celebrate the Jubilee.

Jubilee years have been common in the Church since 1300 when Pope Boniface VII established the regular practice of Holy Year. At first they were celebrated every century, then every half-century, and finally every 25 years, allowing each generation to experience the graces of the year-long celebration. The concept of "Jubilee" has its origins in the Book of Leviticus (chapter 25) as a special year of reconciliation, pilgrimage, and coming home.

During this Jubilee year a Plenary Indulgence can be obtained in various ways. (To be covered next week).

What is an indulgence? "An Indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven." It can be obtained for yourself or for souls in Purgatory.
