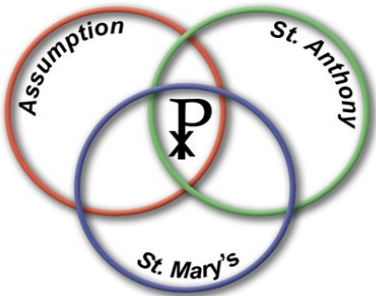

Father's Corner: Indulgences
To understand indulgences we must understand the double consequence of sin. Sin primarily cuts us off from God and leads to the loss of eternal life. The Sacrament of Confession restores this communion and restores eternal life.

The second effect of sin is that sins, even venial sins, entail an unhealthy attachment to evil. This must be purified either here on earth or in Purgatory. This called the "temporal punishment" of sin. It is not meant as a punishment but as opening our lives and souls up to the Grace of God. By sacrificing to obtain an Indulgence, we are in truth purifying ourselves and doing this "temporal punishment."

Make a Pilgrimage to Rome, to at least one of the four Major Papal Basilicas, or to another designated pilgrimage site. St. Joseph Parish in Pocatello is one such Pilgrimage site. We are in the process of trying to get a site in our Deanery designated as a Pilgrimage site. When and if it is, Father Paul will announce it. Another way to receive the indulgence is by attending Mass offered for the Jubilee. These will be scheduled in our parishes throughout this year. Another way is, if with a devout spirit, you participate in popular missions, spiritual exercises, or formation activities on the documents of the Second Vatican Council and the Catechism. Since in a special way during this year of hope, we are called to be signs of hope for those experiencing hardships, doing the "corporal works of mercy: feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked, welcome the stranger, heal the sick, visit the imprisoned and bury the dead." And the "Spiritual Works of Mercy: to counsel the doubtful, instruct the ignorant, admonish sinners, comfort the afflicted, forgive offenses, bear patiently those who do us ill, and pray for the living and the dead."

The Jubilee Plenary Indulgence is obtained by putting into practice in a concrete and generous way the spirit of penance that is the soul of the Jubilee. For example: by abstaining from distractions like use of media and/or social networks for a day, fasting, and abstinence, and donating to the poor.
