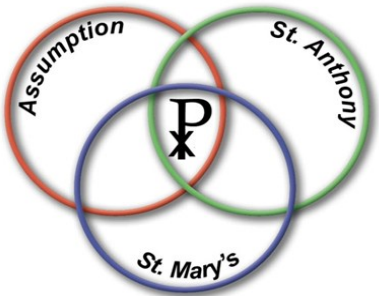

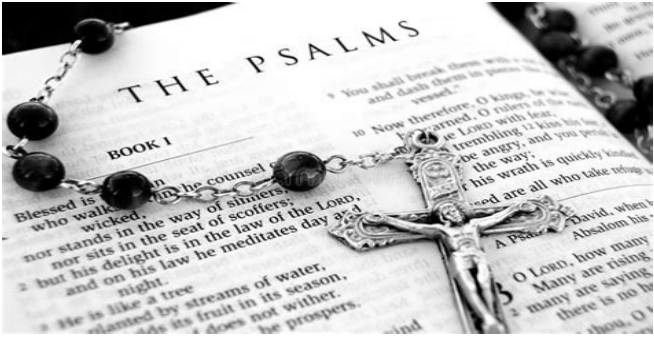

Father's Corner: Dedication of a Church
St. Mary's was dedicated on April 4, 1972; St. Anthony was dedicated on September 25, 1962; Assumption was dedicated on May 28, 1963; and Holy Cross was dedicated on May 26, 1912.

But what is the dedication of a Church and why do we do it? This used to be called the Consecration of the Church. It is a solemn blessing of a new church building by the diocesan Bishop. The Rite, the ceremony, for the Dedication of a Church and an Altar are in the Roman Pontifical, a book of ceremonies done by a bishop.

The Rite begins with the blessing of the site of the new church and the blessing and laying of the foundation stone. After the building is completed the dedication ceremony has four parts: 1) The entrance into the Church by the Bishop and the handing over of the Church to the Bishop by those involved in its construction. 2) The Liturgy of the Word. 3) The prayer of Dedication and the Anointing of the church walls and altar with Sacred Chrism, the incensation of the altar and the church and the covering of the altar with the altar cloth and the lighting of the candles on the altar. 4) The celebration of the Holy Eucharist.

We dedicate a church not merely bless it since it is set aside permanently for divine worship. The church building is an image of the Church built from living stones - you and me. It is where the Eucharist - the Body of Christ - is kept and the place where Christians assemble to hear the Word of God, to pray, and praise the Lord and Celebrate the Holy Mysteries.

The Altar is where the people of God partake in the Lord's Sacrifice, and it stands as a sign of Christ Himself, as the priest, victim, and altar of His own sacrifice.

Question of the Week: What are the Divine Praises?
This is the prayer: "Blessed be God. Blessed be His Holy Name. Blessed be Jesus Christ, true God and true man ... etc." You can find it on the back of the missals for use in Benediction. They are a sequence of acclamations blessing God, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, the Virgin Mary and saints. They were written in 1797 by Luigi Felici, S.J. to make reparations for the use of profane language (cussing) and blasphemy.
