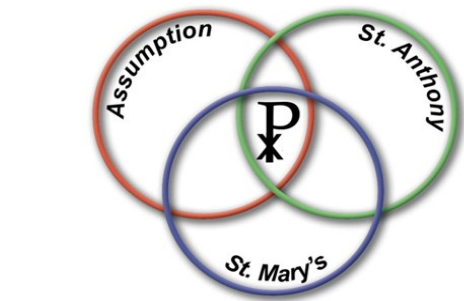

Father’s Corner: The Easter Season
The fifty days following Easter is called the Easter season. The season is 50 days because it is seven times seven (49) and celebrating on the next day, the 50th day. This extended feast answers the human need to celebrate festivals over time. The fiftieth day is Pentecost.

In the Easter Season the Scriptures at Mass focus on three topics. First is the joyful fact that Jesus has indeed Risen from the Dead, not a ghost, but a whole person with Body and Soul. Jesus has conquered sin and its consequences; the final consequence was death. By His Resurrection, He showed that God is greater than anything else.

The second point is that we hear about the spreading and growth of the Church. How people begun to believe and to have faith in the Risen Christ and the forgiveness of our sins. This then encourages each of us today, to believe in the Risen Christ and that He can and will forgive our sins.

The third point is that Jesus is and continues to be present totally within and as the Holy Eucharist that He gave at the Last Supper and continues to give to us in every Mass.

In the Eucharist, Jesus, the Risen Christ, is totally present Body and Soul for us to receive Him today. This is His way of being present with us down through the ages. When He appeared to His disciples they were afraid. As the Eucharist He can come to us and we are not afraid. As one of the prayers for Adoration says, “I thank You for hiding beneath the Eucharistic species Your infinite majesty and beauty, which Your Angels delight to behold, so that I might have courage to approach the throne of Your mercy.”
