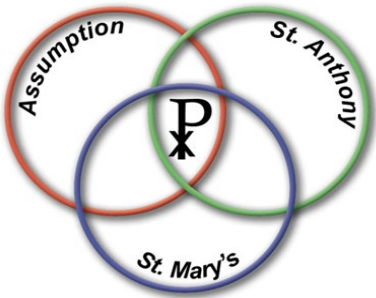

Father's Corner: Ascension of the Lord

This Thursday is Ascension of the Lord, 40 Days since Easter and the celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord.

In parts of the World it is still celebrated this Thursday. In 1998 in Western USA and Canada the celebration of this Feast is moved to the following Sunday, the 7th Sunday of Easter. Why did it get moved from the traditional day? It is one of the three major Feast Days of Easter - the others being Easter itself and Pentecost. As such it was a Holy Day of Obligation. However, the Bishops of the NCCB realized that many Catholics were not making it to mass on the Holy Day and so were missing this important Feast. The Pope gave permission to each NCCB to move the Feast if they wished. The Western Bishops did and then a year or so later most of the rest of the Bishops in the USA did so.

What is the Feast for? It is a celebration of Christ's return to Heaven under His own power. It marks the close of the visible mission of Jesus on earth and the appearance in heaven of His total humanity glorified and His place in the position of honor at the side of the Father. It is from this seat of glory that Jesus, with the Father, sent the Holy Spirit down on the disciples on Pentecost and it is from here that He will come to the final general judgement at the end of time.

The theme of the Ascension is that "Christ has passed beyond our sight, not to abandon us but to be our hope."

Where Jesus has gone - into Heaven - we hope to follow. Although Jesus has gone physically into Heaven, He is present with us spiritually, in His ministers, in His assembly - the Church - in His Word proclaimed - in all the Sacraments especially in the Eucharist (in His Real Presence). Christ promises to be with us until the end of the world.

Question of the Week: What was Limbo? Limbo was an old teaching, thought up by Saint Augustine. He was arguing with a group of people who claimed that if your parents were Baptized, then you did not need to be since they could not pass original sin on to you. Saint Augustine argued that everyone needed Baptism to be saved since Jesus told His disciples to go out and baptize (Mt 28:16-20). But then what about babies who die before they can be baptized? Saint Augustine could not see how they could be in Heaven, but he also could not see how a loving God could put a baby into Hell through no fault or sin of their own. So he came up with Limbo, a happy neutral place not part of Heaven or Hell. This was never officially accepted by the Church or officially a Church teaching. We now understand and believe children who die before Baptism do go to Heaven. They receive the Grace of Baptism through *Baptism by Desire* or *Blood* or just by the Graces of a Loving and Merciful God.
