

**Father's Corner...** Ordinary Time

Today is the 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time on the Church's Calendar. You may ask where are weeks 1-13? Ordinary Time is divided into two parts: Part 1– is Baptism of the Lord in January and the beginning of Lent. Part 2 - of Ordinary Time is between Pentecost and Advent.

Ordinary Time is the longest season of the Church's Year: 33 or 34 weeks long. The length depends on how Christmas and the Baptism of the Lord can change on days of the week.

Ordinary Time begins the day after the Baptism of the Lord, which is on Sunday or Monday; so the first Sunday after the Baptism of the Lord is called the Second Sunday of Ordinary Time. During Ordinary Time we have a semi-continuous reading of one of the three Synoptic Gospels. The Gospel sets the tone for the Sunday celebration. Each Sunday we celebrate God's great deeds. We pray to the Father through the Son in unity with the Holy Spirit. Yet in each celebration we enter this action through ever-fresh facets of our faith as proclaimed in the Liturgy of the Word. During Ordinary Time the color used is green representing life.


