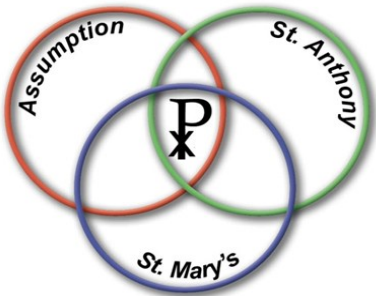

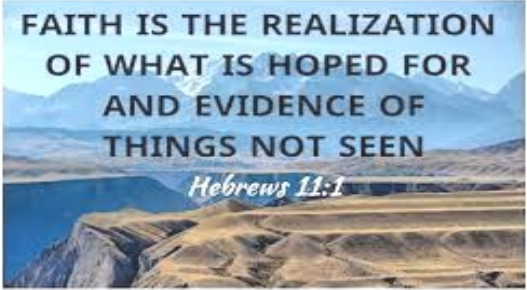

**Father's Corner...
What is the Deposit of Faith?**

It is God revealing Himself to us. The full and definitive stage of God's revelation of Himself to creation is accomplished in His Word made flesh, Jesus Christ. Jesus is the fullness of all Revelation. In sending of the Son and the gift of the Holy Spirit, Revelation is now fully complete.

Since the coming of Jesus Christ we have struggled to understand and to grasp fully this complete revelation of God.

This deposit of Faith is transmitted down through the ages in Sacred Tradition and in the Scriptures. It is entrusted to the whole Church assisted by the Holy Spirit and guided by the Magisterium, and we are called to never cease to welcome and go more deeply and live more fully this gift of Divine Revelation.

The task of giving an authentic interpretation of the deposit of faith is the job of the living teaching office of the Church alone. That is the Magisterium which is the successor of Peter, the Bishop of Rome, and the Bishops in communion with him - that is the Pope and the Bishops in union with him. The Magisterium are the ones who define dogmas which are the formulations of the truths contained in Divine Revelation. This authority also extends to those truths necessary connected with Divine Revelation.

Sacred Scripture, Sacred Tradition, and the Magisterium are all closely united with each other that one of them can not stand without the others. Under the action of the Holy Spirit they all contribute to the salvation of souls.
