

Father's Corner...

Creation, Evolution, and Big Bang: Pierra Teilhard de Chardin S.J. (May 1881-

April 1955). His background.

A French Jesuit, Catholic Priest, scientist and paleontologist, philosopher, mystic and teacher. He investigated the theory of evolution from a perspective influence by Henri Bergson and Christian mysticism.

In 1962 the Holy Office issued a warning regarding his work without specifying what any errors or concerns were. Pope Benedict and Pope Francis made positive comments about some of his ideas. He served in World War I as a stretcher-bearer and received several citations including the Medalle Militaire and Legion of Honor, the highest French order of merit both military and civil.

Between his death (1955) and 1962; several of his books that he had written but in obedience to the Church never published, were published by his friends. In 1962 the Congregation for the Doctrine of Faith cautioned on his works, saying that they contained ambiguities and even serious error. Although, they did NOT place any of his writings on the Index Librorum Prohibitorum (Index of Forbidden Books). Afterwards several prominent clerics mounted a strong theological defense of his works. Pope Benedict XVI used his theology in his "Introduction of Christianity" book; "as an important service of Teihard de Chardin's that he rethought these ideas from the angle of the modern view of the world and, in spite of not entirely unobjectionable tendency toward the biological approach, nevertheless on the whole grasped them correctly and in any case made them accessible once again."

Question of the Week: What to believe when science and Sacred Scripture appear to conflict like in the creation of the universe and evolution?

Science and Sacred Scripture both are about revealing the Truth. Science, theology, mathematics, and philosophy all say that "two things that are true cannot be mutually exclusive." IF A is true and B is true, than A cannot make B untrue. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says "Though faith is above reason, there can never be a contradiction between faith and science because both originate in God. It is God Himself who gives to us the light of both reason and faith." (159)

If science and Sacred Scripture both reveal what is true, then they CANNOT be in conflict. If they appear to be then one or the other is not understood correctly.

Much of the apparent conflict comes because science is about How; and religion and faith are about Who and Why.

God created so He could share His love. How God created is a science issue and faith does not care how.

Father Juniper Serra:

Father Juniper Serra was born in 1713 in Spain and died in 1784 at the Mission San Carlos in what is now California. Father Juniper Serra was Beatified by Pope John Paul II and Canonized (declared a Saint) on September 23, 2015, in the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. by Pope Francis.

His parents were farmers. At 15 years old he went to attend classes at the Cathedral of Palma. He was ordained a priest in December 1738. In January of 1749 he was called to serve as an Indian Missionary in America.

Junipero arrived in Vera Cruz, Mexico, on December 7, 1749, and then walked 250 miles to Mexico City. Between 1750 and 1758 he oversaw the construction of five churches and promoted religious and economic development.

In 1768, Junipero embarked on an expedition to Upper California. He oversaw the establishment of 15 missions from San Jose del Cabo to Santa Maria. Nine of those are in Upper California including San Diego, San Carlos, San Antonio, San Gabriel, San Luis Obispo, San Francisco, San Juan Capistrano, Santa Clara, and San Buenaventura.

Junipero Serra was known for his zeal, optimism and devotion to his converts. He is widely recognized as the Apostle of California.
