

Father's Corner... From the Vatican News Letter 8/22/2025.

The Apostolic Library and the Apostolic Archive (Part 1/3)

Vatican Apostolic Library and the Vatican Apostolic Archive are institutions that combine tradition and innovation. The Library has the task of collecting and preserving a rich heritage and making it avail-

abe to scholars. The Archives carry out their specific task of safeguarding the acts and documents concerning the government of the Church. By Amedeo Lomonaco.

The institutional distinction between the Library, an "institution of conservation and research," and the Archives, which carries out an activity of "intellectual charity" because it shares its heritage with scholars from all over the world, dates back to 1600, with Paul V.

The Vatican Apostolic Library, born in the heart of the Renaissance, is an institution that is equipped to face contemporary challenges. In the 15th century, Nicholas V. decided that Latin, Greek, and Hebrew manuscripts held by the Vatican should be open for consultation and reading by scholars. On 15 June 1475, during the pontificate of Sixtus IV, the Bull Ad decoren militantis Ecclesiae ("For the adornment of the Church militant") was issued.

The distinctive features and purposes of the Vatican Apostolic Library have, since its origins, been linked to an inestimable heritage - as Paul VI recalled in 1975 - to be made available "to scholars in the various stages of consultation, reading, comparison, and final synthesis." This is not just a matter of physically opening rooms or opening texts, but above all, as Pope Paul VI emphasized of a "cultural openness" that can be fostered by preserving and transmitting knowledge.
