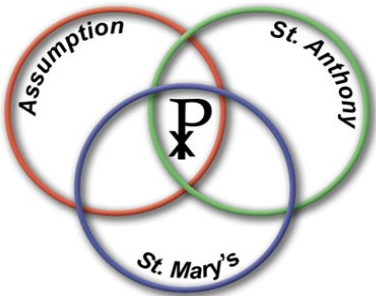

Father's Corner... The Beach part 4
Looking at the ocean as you walk on the beach or by looking at the ocean from the balcony on your motel room all you can see is the surface of the water. You cannot see what is below. Our technology can show us what is living below in the waters and rising from the sea floor. And then our science can think about it and explain what is going on.

What we think of God it is almost a reversal. We can reason our way to God. I have written about those ways before: the first cause, the primary mover, creation cannot be a result of coincidence to any reasonable person, and more. This is the surface. But what else about God? What is underneath the surface of God? What is He like? Why does He do what He did or does? What is His makeup and more? This can only be known through Revelation. What God reveals to us through the Scriptures, private revelation, and most perfectly through Jesus who is the full revelation of God to us. These revelations, reveal beyond the surface of who God is. Then we think and study what is revealed - this is our theology.

Jesus revealed the existence of the Holy Trinity: 3 Person, Father, Son, Spirit, in One Divine God. Jesus revealed that God is love and that God wants to forgive us. But do we think about this revelation? Do we learn from it?

Are you still learning? What are you doing to deepen your understanding of God? Could you live now, as an adult, doing your work with what you knew when you graduated from High School? I am willing to say that is a No. Each of us has continued to learn new things as we go through our lives. Can you continue to live knowing just what you knew about God when you were Confirmed? What do you do to deepen your knowledge of God, to deepen your faith, to grow in your relationship with our Creator, Savior, and the Living presence of God in our lives?
