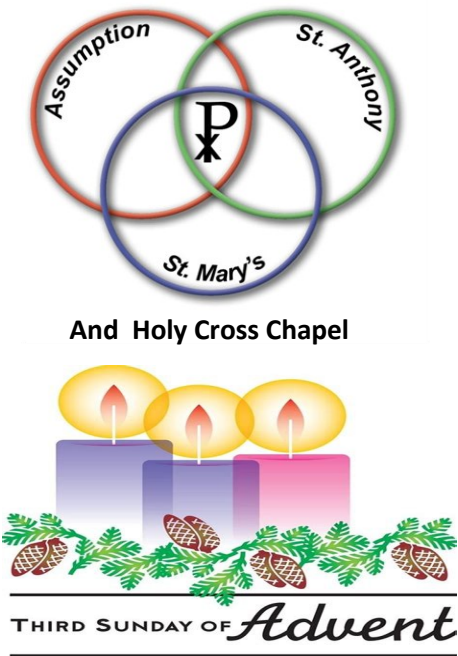

Father's Corner...
Origin of the Twelve Days of Christmas
You are familiar with the Christmas song "The Twelve Days of Christmas." To most it is a delightful nonsense rhyme set to music, but it had quite a serious purpose when it was written. It is a great deal more than just a repetitious melody with a list of strange gifts. Catholics in England during 1558 to 1829, when Parliament finally emancipated Catholics in England, were prohibited from ANY practice of their faith - by law - either privately or public. It was a Crime to be a Catholic. "The Twelve Days of Christmas" was written in England as one of the "catechism songs" to help young Catholics learn the tenets of their faith - a memory aid - when to be caught with anything in *writing* indicating adherence to the Catholic faith could not only get you imprisoned, it could get you hanged, or shortened by a head, or drawn and quartered, all very ghastly punishments. The songs' gifts are hidden meanings to the teachings for the faith. The "True Love" mentioned in the song refers to God Himself. The 'Me" who receives the presents refers to every baptized person. The "Partridge in a Pear Tree" is Jesus Christ, the Son of God. In the song Christ is symbolically presented as a mother Partridge which feigns injury to decoy predators from her helpless nestlings, much in memory of the expression of Christ's sadness over the fate of Jerusalem: "Jerusalem! Jerusalem! How often would I have sheltered thee under my wings, as a hen does her chicks, but thou wouldst not have it so ..." (Matthew 23:37) The other symbols mean the following:
2 Turtle Doves - The Old and New Testaments
3 French Hens - Faith, Hope and Charity, the three Theological Virtues (also represents the Trinity)
4 Calling Birds - The four Gospels and/or the four Evangelists
5 Golden Rings - The first five Books of the Old Testament, the "Pentateuch", which gives the history of humanities' fall from grace.
6 Geese A-laying - the six days of Creation
7 Swans a Swimming - the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit and the Seven Sacraments
8 Maids A-milking - the Eight Beatitudes
9 Ladies Dancing - the nine Fruits of the Holy Spirit
10 Lords A-leaping - the Ten Commandments
11 Pipers Piping - the Eleven faithful Disciples
12 Drummers Drumming - the Twelve points of the doctrine of the Apostles Creed. .
