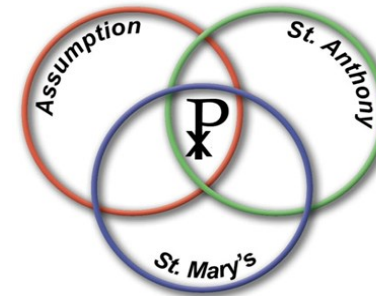

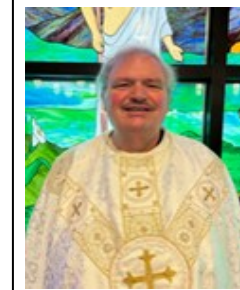


The Rosary is prayed EVERY morning at St. Mary's; Sunday at 6:30 am; the rest of the week at 7:30 am.

Father's Corner... Mother's Day (continued)

Children have responsibilities to their parents as well. There is a whole Commandment dedicated to just this: "Honor your father and your mother, that you may have a long life in the land the Lord Your God is giving you." (Ex 20:12) All of us are called to honor our parents: who gave us life; took care of us when we were young; enabled us to grow in stature, wisdom, and grace; and who handed knowledge of God to us. Jesus did this when "he went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them" (Lk 2:41-52). This is the commandment with a promise: that of a long life if we live it. It requires honor, affection and gratitude toward our parents, elders, ancestors and those with authority over us like teachers, employers, and civil leaders.

Whether we are minors or adults, we owe this to our mothers and fathers. The book of Ben Sira says, "with your whole heart honor your father; your mother's birth pangs do not forget. Remember; of these parents you were born: what can you give them for they gave you?" (Sir 7:27-28). The Book of Proverbs says, "keep your father's commandments, and forsake not your mother's teaching ... When you walk, they will lead you; when you lie down, they will watch over you; and you awake, they will talk with you." (Prov 6:20-22).

As long as a child lives at home with his/her parents, they should obey their parents in all they ask when it is for the child's good, or that of the family. "Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord." (Col 3:20). Once a child has grown to adulthood, they should still continue to respect their parents, anticipate their wishes, willingly seek their advice and accept their just admonitions. (CCC 2217). Respect for ones parents never stops and is rooted in respect of God.

The 4th Commandment tells grown children they as much as they can, they need to give their parents material and moral support in their old age and in times of illness, loneliness, or distress. Jesus did this on the Cross. "When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple there . . . He said to the disciple, 'behold your mother'. And from that hour the disciple took her into his home." (Jn 19 26-27).

What are you doing to show love, give honor and respect to your Mother? Husbands, your wife is the mother of your children. What are going to do to show your honor, respect, and love for her?

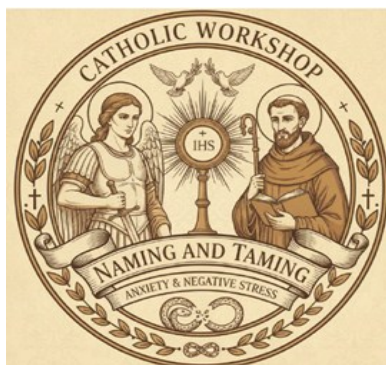
