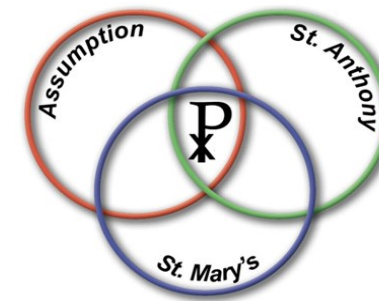

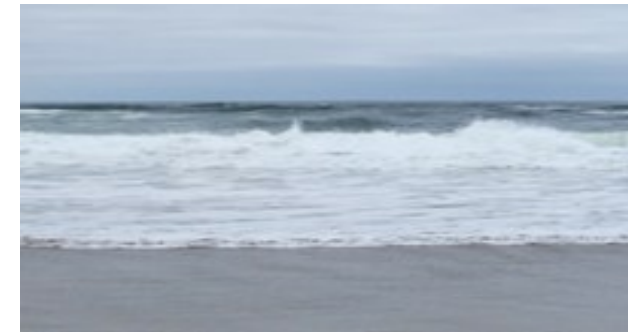

Father's Corner ... Reflection One from the Beach

I was walking along the beach through the incoming waves in my new water shoes that can get wet. If I stood still the sand under my feet would shift throwing me off balance. If I kept walking as the waves hit me, they would push me off balance.

This made me think of St. Peter walking on the water towards Jesus (Mt 14:22-33). How did that work? Did the waves just stop? Did the water just flatten out? Did he walk up and down the waves as they came by him? Did the waves wash by on either side of him and tower over his head or were they barely knee high?

What was the surface like that he walked on? Was it like the sand on the beach that shifted under him, like the sand was doing to me as the waves washed in? Was he walking on the very surface of the water or did he sink in a few inches as he walked?

As I kept walking a wave came in that was going to hit me about knee high. I stopped because I knew the pressure of the wave could make me unstable when it hit. Then of course the sand started to shift under my shoes so my feet started to sink into the sand.

Is this what Peter felt? Did he lose his balance? Did his feet sink deeper into the watery surface? Is that what scared him? We don't know the answer to any of these questions. All the Scripture says is that Peter walked on the water.

If it was you, what would you do and feel? If you felt yourself being knocked off balance, or if you were taking a step and sinking several inches in to the water, or if the waves were passing by you over your head? Would you call out to Jesus to "Save Me!" ?
