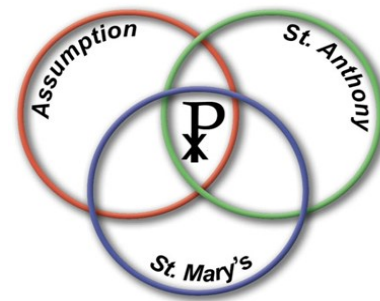

Reflection two from the Beach
 As I am looking at the waves hitting the rocks across the bay and then sweep along them, I thought of how God is always sending us His Holy Spirit to try to guide each of us the way that He knows is best for us.
