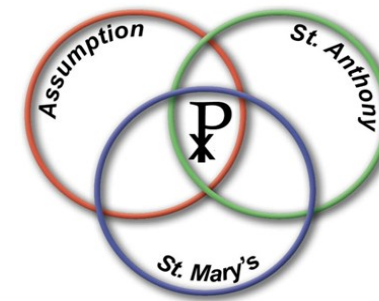

**Father's Corner ... Reflection three from the Beach**

Looking at the birds on the rocks, I wondered when do they know it is safe to stay there and when do they fly off before the waves wash over them? This made me ask, "How do we know what the will of God is for us?"

In the Gospel of Mark, 1:29-39, Jesus heals Simon's mother-in-law and then many others who were sick and cast out many demons. The

next morning "...before day, he (Jesus) rose and went to a lonely place and there he prayed" (Mk 1:35). People were looking for him (Mk 1:37). St. Luke makes it clear that the people intended to keep Jesus there and not allow him to leave (Lk 4:42-44).

After doing all the healings and receiving such positive affirmation, Jesus had to discover what God's will was for him. Did God want him to be a miracle worker? He could make a good living that way. Or did God want him to do something else? So Jesus went and prayed for guidance. When the disciples found him he said to them, "I preach the good news of the Kingdom of God to the other cities also; for I was sent for this purpose." (Lk 4:43).

There are many other examples of Jesus praying for guidance: The Lord's prayer (Mt 6:9-13); the Agony in Gethsemane (Mt 26:36-46; Mk 14:32-42; Lk 22:41-44). Choosing the Disciples (Lk 6:12); from the Cross (Lk 23:34, 46); at the Tomb of Lazarus (Jn 11:41-42); and the High Priestly Prayer for himself and the disciples (Jn 17:1-26). To name some examples.

"To know God's will for us?" We need to first turn to prayer. Ask God to show you His will or to tell you His will for you. And then LISTEN! So often we do not ask God what His will is. We just go on with what we want. And then when we do pray we can get so busy talking that we never allow God to speak to us or we do not listen for Him to talk to us. Other ways to discern God's will for you: Talk it over with someone who you know is a person who prays themselves and ask them to pray for and with you for guidance. Or another means is to pray for guidance and then read from the Scriptures and see what God tells you.

In the Old Testament God often spoke the awesome Theophanies of thunder, lightening and earthquakes. In the New Testament God speaks to us through Jesus and the Apostles. And in our time today, God speaks to us through Sacred Scriptures and through his disciples. And we are each disciples of Jesus.
