Father's Corner ...
Covenants of the Bible, part 2 of 6.
Creation: Adam and Eve.
This Covenant is formed over the time from the very beginning of creation to the Fall of Humanity and the announcement of the punishment and future Savior. This Covenant is mostly one-sided, it is unconditional. The oath - or what to do - God promises to preserve the world and to rescue humanity and all creation through the "offspring of the woman" (Gn 3:15), God promised to send a Savior. The sign of the Covenant is the "offspring of the woman." All that humanity has to do is to accept the "offspring of the woman." The Virgin Mary did this when she said, "Let it be done to me according to your word." (Lk 1:38). This Covenant is finished, totally fulfilled, by God sending us Himself as the Savior in the person of Jesus, and by humanity in the person of Jesus who is the Savior.
Noah: This is an unconditional Covenant. When sin had enveloped the whole world, sending it back into chaos, God sends the Great Flood making way for a restored creation that began with Noah and his family (Gn 6-9). It ends with God making a Covenant with Noah and through him with all of creation. God promises, that despite humanity's corruption. God will never destroy the earth with a flood again (Gn 8:20-22; 9:8-11). The Sign of this Covenant is the rainbow (Gn 9:12-17). (To be continued next week Part 2).

Question of the Week: Difference between dogma and doctrine?
A Doctrine is any official teaching of the Church regarding faith and morals. A Dogma is a specific subset of doctrine; it is a divinely revealed truth that the Church has formally defined and requires all Catholics to believe as an essential part of their faith. Put it simply: all dogmas are doctrines, but not all doctrines are dogmas.

	Dogma	Doctrine
Definition	Truths revealed by God found in Scripture or Sacred Tradition	Any teaching by the Church's Magisterium, teachings, rules or traditions
Status	Infallible- either declared or general-, unchangeable and required for salvation	Can vary, some are authoritative but are open to refinement or deeper understanding
Examples	The Trinity, The Divinity of Christ, The Immaculate Conception and Assumption of Mary, the Real Presence in the Eucharist.	Just war theory, the prohibition of women's ordination, papal encyclicals.
