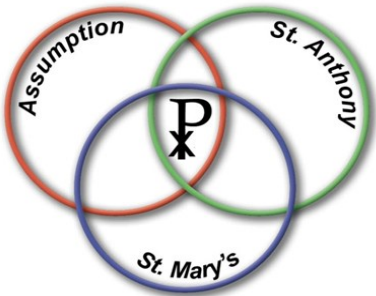

Father's Corner ...
Covenants of the Bible, part 3 of 6. The Abrahamic Covenant. God continues his promises to preserve the world and to rescue humanity - see Creation Covenant - when God calls Abraham into a Covenantal relationship. God promises Abraham 1.) A great number of descendants (Gen 15:5; 17:2; 17:15-16) 2.) A piece of land in Canaan (Gen 12:7; 15:17-21; 22:18) and 3.) that the whole world would be blessed through him (Gen 12:3; 15; 17; 22:18). The Sign of this Covenant is that every male is to be circumcised. (Gen 17:9-14). Abraham's part is to have all the males circumcised and to put his faith in God. The first promise is fulfilled in Isaac & Jacob and his many sons. The second promise is fulfilled when the Israelites move into the promised land after Moses. It begins in the Book of Joshua. The third promise is fulfilled in Jesus Christ through whom all the world is blessed. (Gal 3:8; 16; Acts 3:25; John 3:16; 12:47).
The Mosaic Covenant: This is the central Covenant in the Old Testament. It is the heart of the rest of the Old Testament. After the Jews had been enslaved in Egypt, God sent Moses to lead them to freedom. When Pharaoh refuses, God sends the 10 plagues. The Jews led by Moses leave Egypt and after many trials end at the base of Mount Sinai. (Exodus and Deuteronomy). Moses acting as the representative for Israel ascends the mountain to make the covenant with God (Ex 19:20). God promises to make Israel into a holy kingdom of priests that will spread His blessings and glory to all the nations. God will be their God and bless them and the people will follow His laws (Dt 28). The heart of which is in the Ten Commandments (Ex 20). The Sign of the Covenant is the way the people live in keeping His commands. (To be continued next week Part 4).
